

United Methodist Church of Clinton



In late June, I drove down to Virginia to visit with family and friends. I had a great time catching up with my cousins and college roommate, and being introduced to some of my cousin Erica's military buddies. While driving back to Connecticut from

Virginia on Route 81-N, I saw a huge disturbing billboard sign at exit 77 which read, "Jesus is not God! He did not pre-exist in heaven".

Having to catch my breath in disappointment without swerving my car, I said in a gentle and quiet voice, "Wow – Just Wow". I felt my heart hurting, perhaps even stop beating for a millisecond.

After coming back "to earth, to life", I began to reflect upon the bold statement that was written on the billboard. And as a theologian, ordained elder in the United Methodist Church, a former seminarian, and simply a follower of Christ, I embraced the uncomfortable opportunity and sat in the midst of feeling disappointed.

Unfortunately, the message on the billboard rings true to many people today. There are people who do not believe that Jesus is God, or that God exist. While there

are several schools of thought and different beliefs about Jesus (i.e. He is a good man, a prophet, but not God), we who profess to be followers of Christ, must be clear about who, what, and why we believe in Jesus Christ.

In other words, tell your story about your relationship with Jesus. You have to know without any doubt that Jesus is God, and that He did pre-exist in heaven. He is God who came to earth in human form, and who:

Created the heavens and earth from the beginning

Walked this earth

Performed miracles

Provided a road map and instructions for life (The Bible and Prayer)

Died for our sins on the cross

Conquered death and gave us eternal life (present and future)

Ascended into heaven and is seated on the throne

Will return to earth

Our Friend, Savior, and Beginner of all good things and people

This is just a microscopic representation of who Jesus is - He is so much more! And, yes He is real and He is GOD!

With the world at odds with itself, people hurting and searching for answers, let our living be an example to counteract those negative messages that Jesus is not God...God is not real. Jesus did pre-exist in heaven.

It is not our job to convince people or bully people into believing and wanting Jesus. What we are called to do is live as good examples and love our neighbors, despite the bad examples the world sees from some of our Christian siblings today. We cannot give up, even when we are disappointed or uncomfortable.

I am learning to take those disappointments and uncomfortable moments as learning opportunities for spiritual growth. The billboard sign caused me to ask myself deeper theological, biblical, and spiritual questions about my relationship with Jesus. Not as a means to argue or discredit Christianity. But rather to help me grow in Christ and to make sure my election in Christ is firm and not wavering.

So, the next time I see a disturbing billboard or anything that may challenge my beliefs about my King Jesus, rather than being hurt, the Holy Spirit within me will be able to say, "Yeah, bring it on".











We are not having a SPPRC Picnic due to dates not available.

The month of August is going to be very busy with the three main summer projects being initiated during this time period.

1) Due to leakage in fellowship hall we have contracted Grove Gardens to install three (3) French Drains in the yard

between the church and the parsonage.

- 2) Electronic doors and an intercom system will be installed at the door by the kitchen and in the Kathy Fell building which will allow the office to buzz people in during office hours.

Brief financial comments for UMC-Clinton @ 7/26/25

Our Financial Secretary Jackie recorded and deposited \$216,500 of contributions received for the

twelve months Jul24-Jun25.

- Our Treasurer Carol wrote checks totaling (\$287,600) that cashed Jul24-Jun25
- · UMC-Clinton spent (\$71,100) more than received for twelve months Jul24-Jun25.
- This compares to FY24 of (\$65,100), excluding non-routine expenses.
- · Contributions are flat with last year while routine expenses are up 2-3%.
- · Bank balances and Investments were drawn down to cover the deficit.
- · UMC-Clinton Investments @ 12/31/24 were \$998,600
- (\$40,100) has been withdrawn to cover the deficit thru June 2025.
- The stock market has increased equity values an estimated 3.6% thru June 2025.
- Investments are estimated to be \$994,400 down (\$4,200) @ 7/26/25.




Sunday, September 7th, before church.

It was Graham's first time as an acolyte. Good job!!!






